## DSWD DROMIC Report #12 on the Effects of Easterlies

as of 18 December 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On November 07, 2023, the effects of Easterlies were reported in various locations in the country. Several barangays in Regions X and XII encountered flash floods, widespread flooding and rain-induced landslides necessitating immediate response measures.

On 08 November 2023, the weather disturbance persisted affecting additional areas in Region XI leading to displacement of families and individuals.

Local authorities and disaster management teams are actively engaged in response and early recovery efforts to address the displacement concerns of the affected populations and manage the aftermath of the incidents caused by Easterlies.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **24,135 families** or **86,707 persons** are affected in **30 barangays** in **Regions X, XI, and XII** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **35 families** or **140 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Region XI** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **12 families** or **60 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **47 families** or **200 persons** displaced in **Region XI** (see Annex D).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **174 houses** were damaged; composed of **66 totally damaged** and **108 partially damaged** in **Region X and XI** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱21,780,627.80** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱7,429,127.80** from **DSWD** and **₱14,351,500.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
