





# DSWD DROMIC Report #13 on the Mw 7.4 Earthquake Incident in Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur

as of 15 December 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 02 December 2023 at 10:37 PM, a 7.4-magnitude earthquake jolted the Municipality of Hinatuan, Surigao Del Sur (08.44°N, 126.59°E - 029 km N 74° E) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus 026 km. The earthquake was also felt in nearby municipalities.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 178,808 families or 720,974 persons are affected in 409 barangays in Regions XI and CARAGA (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **56 families** or **280 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Monkayo**, **Davao de Oro**, **Region XI** (see Annex B).

## b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **58 families** or **290 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **114 families**, or **570 persons** still displaced in **Monkayo**, **Davao de Oro**, **Region XI** (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **8,321 houses** were damaged; composed of **366 totally damaged** and **7,955 partially damaged** in **Regions XI** and **CARAGA** (see Annex E).







## V. Cost of DSWD Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}82,332,427.56\$ worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families, of which, \$\mathbb{P}82,265,427.56\$ are **food and non-food items (FNIs)** and \$\mathbb{P}67,000.00\$ are **financial assistance** through **Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS)** (see Table 1).
