

DSWD DROMIC Report #15 on the Mw 7.4 Earthquake Incident in Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur as of 17 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

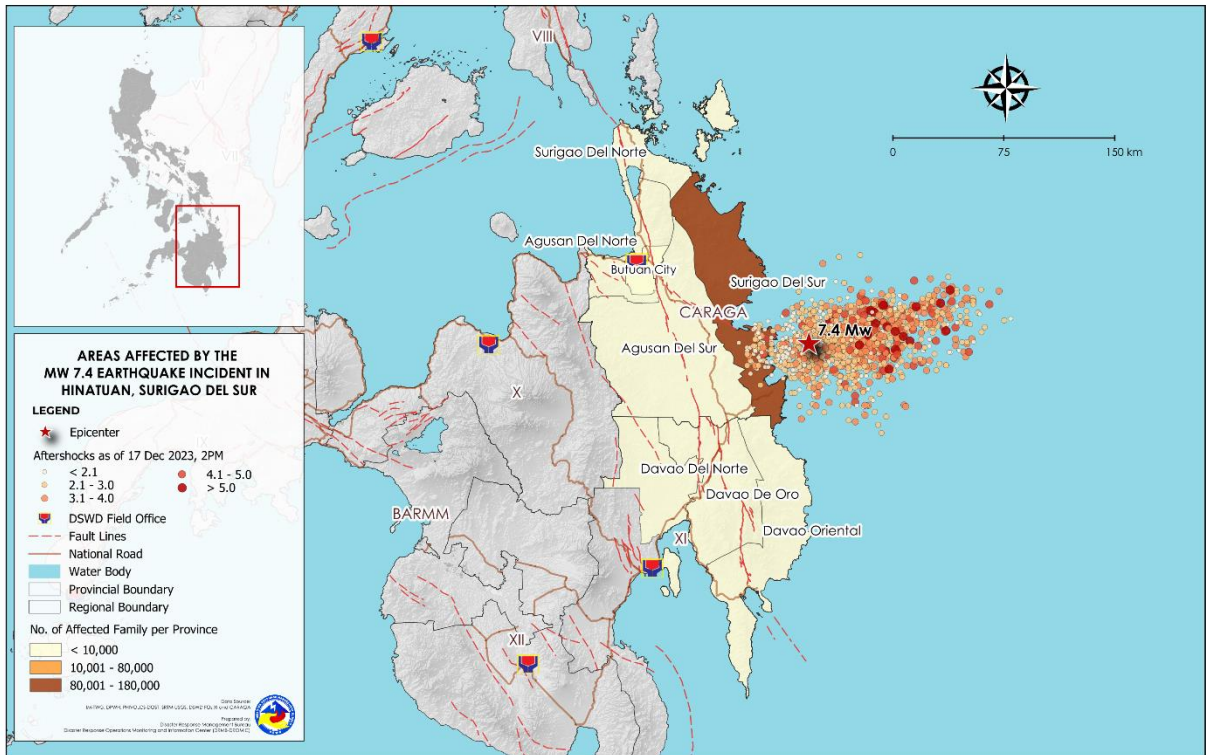
On 02 December 2023 at 10:37 PM, a 7.4-magnitude earthquake jolted the Municipality of Hinatuan, Surigao Del Sur (08.44°N, 126.59°E - 029 km N 74° E) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus 026 km. The earthquake was also felt in nearby municipalities.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **178,808 families** or **720,974 persons** are affected in **409 barangays** in **Regions XI and CARAGA** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **56 families** or **280 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Old Elementary School** in **Brgy. Mount Diwata, Monkayo, Davao de Oro** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **58 families** or **290 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **114 families** or **570 persons** still displaced in **Monkayo, Davao de Oro** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **8,700 houses** were damaged; of which, **385** are **totally damaged** and **8,315** are **partially damaged** in **Regions XI and CARAGA** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of DSWD Assistance Provided

A total of **₱108,549,822.56** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families, of which, **₱103,905,822.56** are **food and non-food items (FNIs)** and **₱4,644,000.00** are **financial assistance through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS)** (see Table 1).
