





# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Maguindanao del Sur

as of 22 December 2023, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 17 December 2023 at around 1:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired in Mamasapano and Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur between two (2) Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) factions that resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

A total of 1,605 families or 8,025 persons are affected in four (4) barangays in Maguindanao del Sur (see Annex A).

There are **1,605 families** or **8,025 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).
