

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Bombing Incident in Marawi City, Lanao del Sur

as of 09 December 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 03 December 2023, a bombing incident occurred at the gymnasium of Mindanao State University, Marawi City, Lanao del Sur affecting several students who have been repatriated and returned to their respective provinces.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **124 persons** are affected by the **Bombing Incident** in **Marawi, City, Lanao del Sur**; of which **93** are from the province of **Zamboanga del Sur**, **17** are from **Zamboanga del Norte**, and **14** are from **Zamboanga Sibugay** in **Region IX** (See Table 1).
