## **DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of Easterlies in Caraga Region**

as of 28 December 2023, 6PM

### **I. Situation Overview**

Issued on 25 December 2023 at 4:00PM, cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and

thunderstorms brought by the Easterlies may have caused possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to heavy rains to Caraga, Davao Region, Northern Mindanao, Eastern Samar, Bohol, and Southern Leyte.

On the same day, the effects of Easterlies were reported in various locations in the Caraga Region. Certain areas of Agusan del Sur were placed under Orange Rainfall Warning Level while provinces of Agusan del Norte, Surigao del Norte, Surigao del Sur and Dinagat Islands experienced Yellow Warning Level. The Easterlies brought significant amount of rain which led to the displacement of families living in low-lying areas. Local authorities and disaster management teams are actively engaged in the response operation to address the displacement concerns of the affected populations and manage the incident caused by Easterlies.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **620 families** or **2,524 persons** are affected in **35 barangays** in **Caraga Region** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **a. Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **53 families** or **212 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Agusan del Norte** and **Agusan del Sur** (see Annex B).

#### **b. Outside Evacuation Center**

A total of **19 families** or **74 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex C).

#### **c. Total Displaced Population**

There are **53 families** or **212 persons** displaced in **Agusan del Norte** and **Agusan del Sur** (see Annex D).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

**One (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Butuan City, Caraga Region** (see Annex E).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱52,752.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Units (LGUs)** to the affected families (see Annex F).
