



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of Northeast Monsoon in Baggao, Cagayan

as of 02 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 30 November 2023 at 4PM, cloudy skies with rains brought by the Northeast Monsoon may have caused possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Aurora, Apayao, Batanes and Cagayan including Babuyan Islands.

On the same day, the municipality of Baggao, Cagayan reported the effects of Northeast Monsoon.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **318 families** or **1,130 persons** are affected in **16 barangays** in **Baggao**, **Cagayan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **42 families** or **170 persons** sought temporary shelter in **six (6)** evacuation centers in Baggao, Cagayan (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **276 families** or **960 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives and/or friends in **Baggao, Cagayan** (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **318 families** or **1,130 persons** displaced in **Baggao, Cagayan** (see Annex D).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱208,800.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
