

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. BF Homes, Paranaque City as of 15 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 December 2023 at around 3:53 PM, a fire incident occurred at Ipil Side, Purok 4, Brgy. BF Homes, Paranaque City. The fire was declared out at around 6:31 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **54 families** or **185 persons** are affected in **Brgy. BF Homes, Paranaque City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **31 families** or **124 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Ipil Main Child Development Center** in **Brgy. BF Homes, Paranaque City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **23 families** or **61 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives and/or friends in **Brgy. BF Homes, Paranaque City** (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **54 families** or **185 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. BF Homes, Paranaque City** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **37 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. BF Homes, Paranaque City** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱258,006.06** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
