I. Situation Overview

On 11 December 2023 at around 3:42 AM, a fire incident occurred at Unit 7, Upper Nawasa, Brgy. Commonwealth, Quezon City. The fire was declared fire out at around 5:47 AM.

A total of **66 families** or **178 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Commonwealth**, **Quezon City** (see Annex A).

A total of **66 families** or **178 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Purok 3 Covered Court** in **Brgy. Commonwealth, Quezon City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **50 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Commonwealth, Quezon City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱309,800.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).

- 45,095 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 36,903 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 8,192 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 1,599 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱1.06 billion worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
