I. Situation Overview

On 14 December 2023, a fire incident occurred at Purok 8, Brgy. Gusa, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 9:15 AM.

A total of **86 families** or **339 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Gusa, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **86 families** or **339 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **East Gusa National High School** in **Brgy. Gusa, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **72 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Gusa, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱99,690.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex D).
