

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion, Iloilo City

as of 17 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 December 2023 at around 4:42 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 6:59 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **79 families** or **395 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **79 families** or **395 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Baluarte Elementary School** in **Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **72 houses** were damaged; of which, **68** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion, Iloilo City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱673,534.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
