

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Leon Garcia, Davao City as of 28 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 December 2023 at around 1:14 AM, a fire incident transpired at Purok San Vicente, Brgy. Leon Garcia, Agdao District, Davao City, resulting in the displacement of families and individuals and damages to residential structures. The fire was placed under control at 5:30 AM and was declared out at around 7:10 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **235 families** or **546 persons** are affected at **Purok San Vicente, Brgy. Leon Garcia, Davao City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **147 families** or **311 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Brgy. Leon Garcia, Davao City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **104 houses** were damaged; of which **101** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** at **Purok San Vicente, Brgy. Leon Garcia, Davao City** (see Annex C).
