

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pusok, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu

as of 14 December 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 12 December 2023 at around 1:25 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Sta. Maria, Brgy. Pusok, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu. The fire continued to spread to the neighboring Sitio Seaside. The fire was declared out at around 4:57 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,252 families** or **6,798 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Pusok, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **1,252 families** or **6,798 persons** are currently taking temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Brgy. Pusok, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **600 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Pusok, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱ 3,505,020.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱ 505,020.00** from **DSWD** and **₱ 3,000,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
