as of 16 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 December 2023 at around 2:40 AM, a fire incident transpired in Brgy. Talaba II, Bacoor City, Cavite. The fire was declared out at around 5:40 AM.

A total of **96 families** or **362 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Talaba II, Bacoor City, Cavite** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 96 families or 362 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Talaba Elementary School in Brgy. Talaba II, Bacoor City, Cavite (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱654,686.00 worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).

15 December 2023	 DSWD FO CALABARZON through its Regional Quick Response Team (RQRT) in coordination with the Bacoor City Action Team conducted Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) in the affected area and in the evacuation center. DSWD FO CALABARZON'S Emergency Operations Center (EOC) together with the Quick Response Teams (QRTs) has been placed on heightened alert status to monitor the effects of the fire incident. DSWD FO CALABARZON closely coordinated with the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) for significant disaster response updates and further relief augmentation requests.
