

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flooding Incidents in Gen. S. K. Pendatun, Maguindanao del Sur

as of 27 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On December 5, 2023, Metro Manila and the entire country experienced partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers, as forecasted by PAGASA, attributed by the localized thunderstorms.

On the same day at around 7:00 PM, heavy rainfall as a result of localized thunderstorms, has led to the occurrence of flooding incidents in various low-lying barangays in the Municipality of General Salipada K. Pendatun, Maguindanao del Sur.

A total of **2,983 families** or **14,915 persons** are affected in **15 barangays** in the municipality of **General Salipada K. Pendatun, Maguindanao del Sur** (see Annex A).
