

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Mw 7.4 Earthquake Incident in Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur as of 04 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

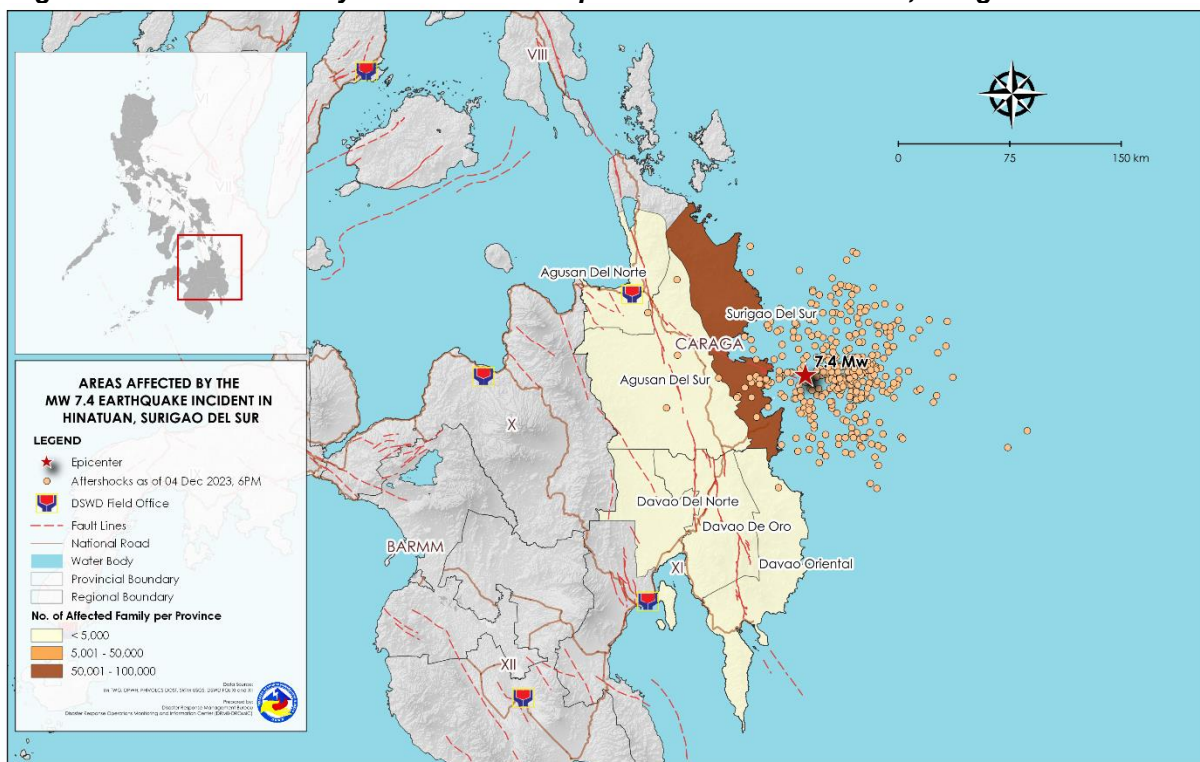
On 02 December 2023 at 10:37 PM, a 7.4-magnitude earthquake jolted the Municipality of Hinatuan, Surigao Del Sur (08.44°N, 126.59°E - 029 km N 74° E) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus 026 km. The earthquake was also felt in the neighboring municipalities.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **100,174 families** or **399,765 persons** are affected in **274 barangays** in **Regions XI** and **CARAGA** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **eight (8) families** or **28 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Region XI** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **576 families** or **1,763 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **584 families** or **1,791 persons** were displaced in **Regions XI** and **CARAGA** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **2,279 houses** were damaged; of which, **193** are **totally damaged** and **2,086** are **partially damaged** in **Regions XI** and **CARAGA** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of DSWD Assistance Provided

A total of **₱65,610.00** worth of **food items** was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Table 1)
