



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Whirlwind Incident in Kabacan, North Cotabato

as of 12 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 09 December 2023 at around 3:40 PM, a whirlwind incident took place in the municipality of Kabacan, North Cotabato causing damages to numerous houses in the surrounding vicinity of the municipality.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **78 families** or **390 persons** are affected in **four (4) barangays** in **Kabacan, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **six (6) families** or **30 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **74 houses** were damaged; of which, **six (6)** are **totally damaged** and **68** are **partially damaged** in **Kabacan, North Cotabato** (see Annex C).
