

## DSWD DROMIC Report #20 on the Mw 6.8 Earthquake Incident in Sarangani, Davao Occidental as of 29 December 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

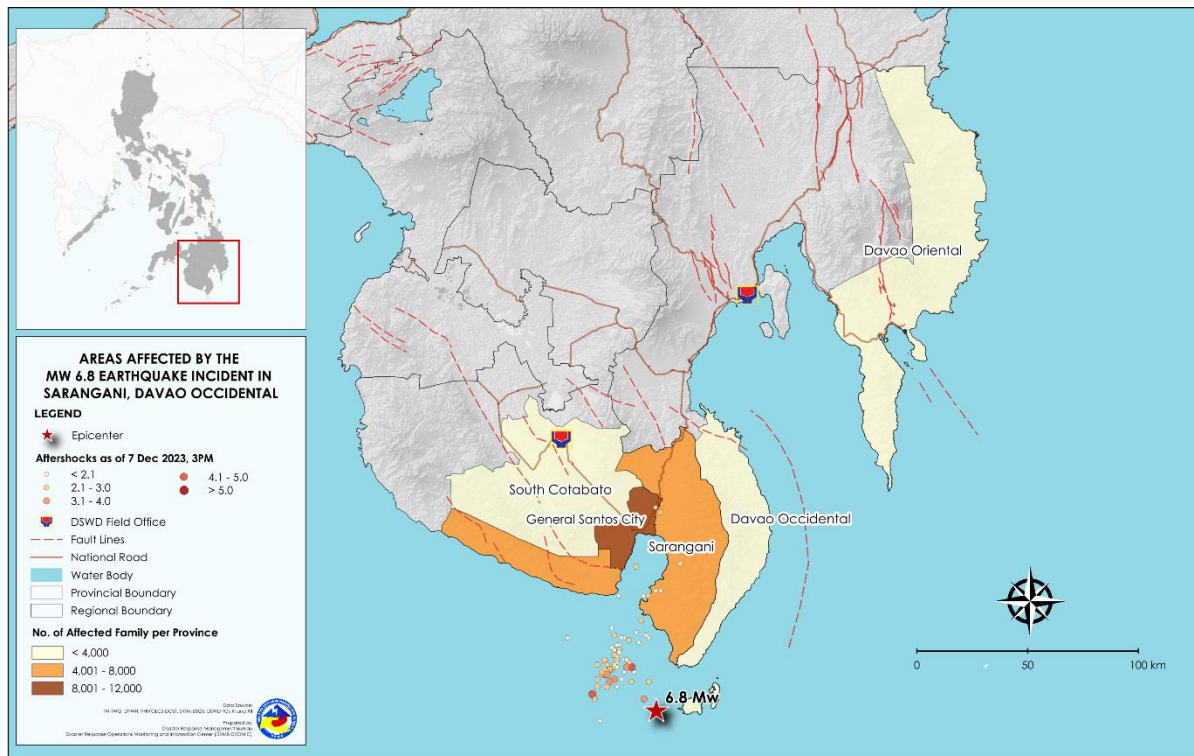
On 17 November 2023 at 4:14 PM, a 6.8-magnitude earthquake jolted the Municipality of Sarangani, Davao Occidental (5.38°N, 125.24°E - 028 km S 68°W) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus 063 km. The earthquake was also felt in the neighboring municipalities.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **21,186 families** or **102,741 persons** are affected in **130 barangays** in **Regions XI and XII** (see Annex A).

## III. Damaged Houses

A total of **7,064 houses** were damaged; of which, **609** are **totally damaged** and **6,455** are **partially damaged** in **Regions XI and XII** (see Annex B).

## IV. Cost of DSWD Assistance Provided

A total of **₱93,339,698.53** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families; of which, **₱47,626,698.53** are **food and non-food items (FNIs)** and **₱45,713,000.00** are **financial assistance** through **Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS)** (see Table 1).
