

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Armed Conflict in Maguindanao del Sur

as of 27 December 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 17 December 2023 at around 1:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired in Mamasapano and Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur between two (2) Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) factions. This event led to the displacement of families and individuals in the affected area and nearby barangays.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region XII provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of affected families and individuals.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,605 families** or **8,025 persons** are affected in **four (4) barangays** in **Maguindanao del Sur** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

There are **1,605 families** or **8,025 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱2,590,965.00** worth of assistance from **DSWD** was provided to the affected families (see Annex C).
