





# DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Bombing Incident in Marawi City, Lanao del Sur

as of 27 December 2023, 6PM

# I. Situation Overview

On 03 December 2023, a bombing incident occurred at the gymnasium of Mindanao State University (MSU) in Marawi City, Lanao del Sur affecting several students from various municipalities of Regions IX, X, and XII.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Offices in Regions IX, X, and XII together with concerned LGUs and other offices promptly provided the immediate needs of the affected individuals through the provision of non-food items and financial assistance through the Assistance for Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS) as well Psychosocial Support Intervention.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **260 persons** are affected by the **Bombing Incident** in **Marawi, City, Lanao del Sur** (See Annex A).

## III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱898,497.02 worth of assistance was provided by DSWD to the affected individuals; of which, ₱3,497.02 are non-food items and ₱895,000.00 are financial assistance through the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) (see Table 1).
