

# DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Effects of Easterlies in Caraga Region

as of 31 December 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 25 December 2023, the effects of Easterlies were reported in various locations in the Caraga Region. Certain areas of Agusan del Sur were placed under Orange Rainfall Warning Level while provinces of Agusan del Norte, Surigao del Norte, Surigao del Sur and Dinagat Islands experienced Yellow Warning Level. The Easterlies brought a significant amount of rain which led to the displacement of families living in low-lying areas.

Local authorities and disaster management teams are actively engaged in the response operation to address the displacement concerns of the affected populations and manage the incident caused by Easterlies.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **620 families** or **2,524 persons** are affected in **35 barangays** in **Caraga Region** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **601 families** or **2,450 persons** sought temporary shelter in **37 evacuation centers** in **Caraga Region** (see Annex B).

### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **19 families** or **74 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex C).

### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **620 families** or **2,524 persons** were displaced in **Caraga Region** (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Butuan City, Agusan Del Norte, Caraga Region** (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱52,752.00** worth of assistance from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** was provided to the affected families (see Annex F).
