





DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion, Iloilo City

as of 19 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 December 2023 at around 4:42 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 6:59 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **84 families** or **273 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion**, **Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 84 families or 273 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Baluarte Elementary School in Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion, Iloilo City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **72 houses** were damaged; of which, **68** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion**, **Iloilo City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}\$1,596,998.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}\$1,513,534.00 from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}\$83,464.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
