



DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Flooding Incident in Malita, Davao Occidental

as of 02 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 November 2023, a flooding incident occurred in the municipality of Malita, Davao Occidental due to heavy rains.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **416 families** or **1,336 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Malita**, **Davao Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **396 families** or **1,236 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Malita, Davao Occidental** (see Annex B);

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **44 houses** were damaged; of which, **17** are **totally damaged** and **27** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Malita, Davao Occidental** (see Annex C).
