





DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Mw 7.4 Earthquake Incident in Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur

as of 05 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 December 2023 at 10:37 PM, a 7.4-magnitude earthquake jolted the Municipality of Hinatuan, Surigao Del Sur (08.44°N, 126.59°E - 029 km N 74° E) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus 026 km. The earthquake was also felt in the neighboring municipalities.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 137,902 families or 548,232 persons are affected in 319 barangays in Regions XI and CARAGA (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **94 families** or **146 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Regions XI and CARAGA** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **eight (8) families** or **30 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives and/or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 102 families or 176 persons still displaced in Regions XI and CARAGA (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **4,188 houses** were damaged; of which, **313** are **totally damaged** and **3,875** are **partially damaged** in **Regions XI** and **CARAGA** (see Annex E).





V. Cost of DSWD Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}\$,364,267.35 worth of assistance was provided by DSWD to the affected families, of which, \$\mathbb{P}\$9,297,267.35 are food and non-food items (FNIs) and \$\mathbb{P}\$67,000.00 are financial assistance through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) (see Table 1).
