

DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion, Iloilo City as of 21 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 December 2023 at around 4:42 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 6:59 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **84 families** or **273 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **84 families** or **273 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Baluarte Elementary School** in **Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **72 houses** were damaged; of which, **68** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion, Iloilo City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of DSWD Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,963,534.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families, of which, **₱643,534.00** are **food** and **non-food items (FNIs)** and **₱1,320,000.00** are **financial assistance** through **Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS)** (see Annex D).
