



# DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion, Iloilo City

as of 21 December 2023, 6PM

# I. Situation Overview

On 16 December 2023 at around 4:42 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Haboghabog Salvacion, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 6:59 AM.

# **II.** Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **84 families** or **273 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion**, **Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **84 families** or **273 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Baluarte Elementary School** in **Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **72** houses were damaged; of which, **68** are totally damaged and four (4) are partially damaged in Brgy. Habog-habog Salvacion, Iloilo City (see Annex C).

# V. Cost of DSWD Assistance Provided

A total of ₱1,963,534.00 worth of assistance was provided by DSWD to the affected families, of which, ₱643,534.00 are food and non-food items (FNIs) and ₱1,320,000.00 are financial assistance through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) (see Annex D).
