





DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tagumpay, Coron, Palawan

as of 05 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 November 2023 at around 1:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tagumpay, Coron, Palawan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **70 families** or **230 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tagumpay, Coron, Palawan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **64 families** or **170 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Hall** in **Brgy. Tagumpay**, **Coron**, **Palawan** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **40 houses** were damaged; of which, **34** are **totally damaged** and **six** (**6)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Tagumpay, Coron, Palawan** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}769,485.40\$ worth of assistance was provided by DSWD to the affected families, of which, \$\mathbb{P}269,485.40\$ are food and non-food items (FNIs) and \$\mathbb{P}500,000.00\$ worth of financial assistance through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) (see Annex D).

- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO MIMAROPA.

- 188,355 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 59,502 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City, and 36,168 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 92,685 FFPs available at DSWD FO MIMAROPA.
- ₱1.23 billion worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO MIMAROPA warehouses.
