





DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Flooding Incident in Malita, Davao Occidental

as of 06 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On the night of November 29, 2023, Malita, Davao Occidental faced intense rainfall, causing flooding in Poblacion's barangays. The Municipality Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) swiftly activated emergency responders for search and rescue operations. The local PAGASA bulletin on November 29, 2023, predicted Mindanao would encounter intermittent heavy rainfall, lightning, strong winds, and thunderstorms due to the Easterlies.

On the night of 29 November 2023, Malita, Davao Occidental faced intense rainfall causing flooding in Barangay Pobacion. As forecasted the local PAGASA weather bulletin Mindanao would encounter intermittent heavy rainfall, lightning, strong winds, and thunderstorms due to the Easterlies. Likewise, the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office MDRRMO), immediately activated the emergency responders to manage the incident caused by the weather system.

A total of **2,593 families** or **8,887 persons** are affected in **four (4) barangays** in **Malita, Davao Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **416 families** or **1,336 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Malita, Davao Occidental** (see Annex B);

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **44 houses** were damaged; **17** of which are **totally damaged** and **27** are **partially damaged** in **Malita, Davao Occidental** (see Annex C).
