



# DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Mw 7.4 Earthquake Incident in Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur

as of 06 December 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 02 December 2023 at 10:37 PM, a 7.4-magnitude earthquake jolted the Municipality of Hinatuan, Surigao Del Sur (08.44°N, 126.59°E - 029 km N 74° E) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus 026 km. The earthquake was also felt in the neighboring municipalities.



## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **144,357 families** or **564,466 persons** are affected in **334 barangays** in **Regions XI** and **CARAGA** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **533 families** or **2,116 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **five (5) evacuation centers** in **Regions XI and CARAGA** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **34,228 families** or **146,418 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives and/or friends (see Annex C).

 c. Total Displaced Population There are 533 families or 2,116 persons still displaced in Regions XI and CARAGA (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **5,120 houses** were damaged; of which, **387** are **totally damaged** and **4,733** are **partially damaged** in **Regions XI** and **CARAGA** (see Annex E).



## V. Cost of DSWD Assistance Provided

A total of ₱21,539,029.65 worth of assistance was provided by DSWD to the affected families, of which, ₱21,472,029.65 are food and non-food items (FNIs) and ₱67,000.00 are financial assistance through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) (see Table 1).
