

DSWD DROMIC Report #5 on the Mw 7.4 Earthquake Incident in Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur as of 07 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

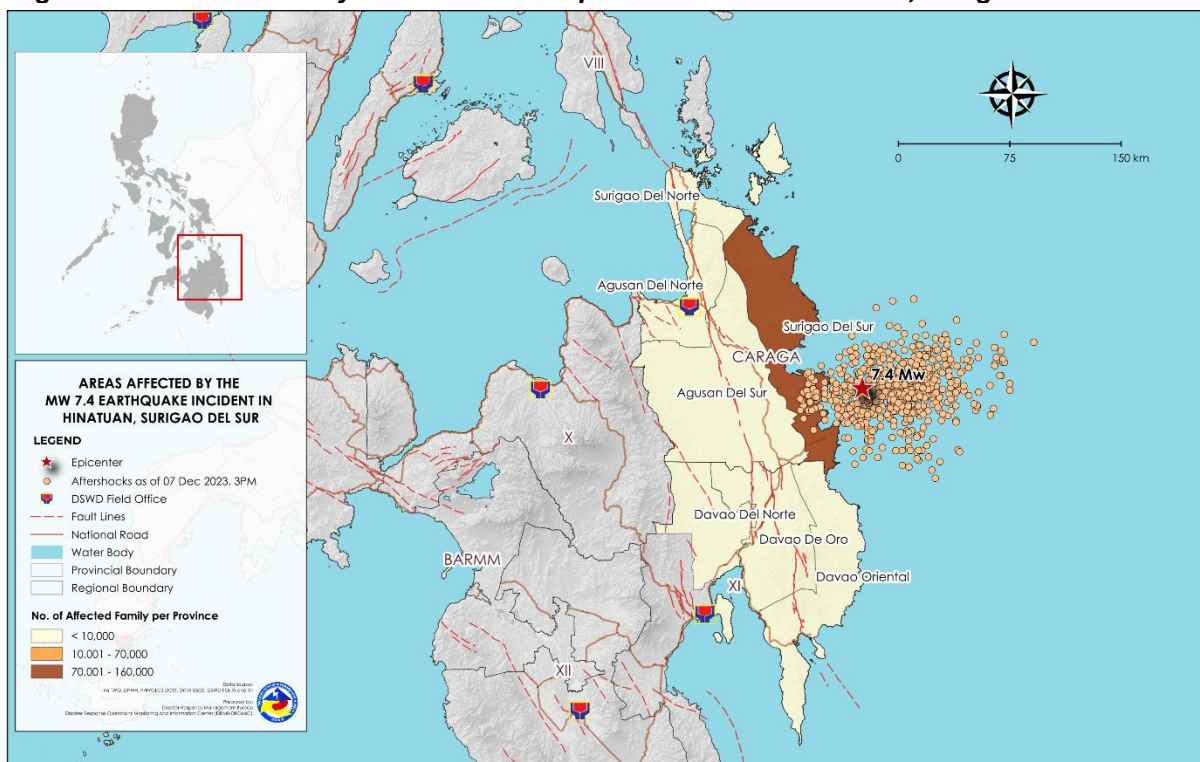
On 02 December 2023 at 10:37 PM, a 7.4-magnitude earthquake jolted the Municipality of Hinatuan, Surigao Del Sur (08.44°N, 126.59°E - 029 km N 74° E) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus 026 km. The earthquake was also felt in the neighboring municipalities.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **151,019 families** or **591,789 persons** are affected in **342 barangays** in **Regions XI** and **CARAGA** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **3,180 families** or **7,457 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **11 evacuation centers** in **Regions XI** and **CARAGA** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **21 families** or **63 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives and/or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **3,201 families** or **7,520 persons** still displaced in **Regions XI** and **CARAGA** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **5,147 houses** were damaged; of which, **397** are **totally damaged** and **4,750** are **partially damaged** in **Regions XI** and **CARAGA** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of DSWD Assistance Provided

A total of **₱47,880,421.75** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families, of which, **₱47,813,421.75** are **food and non-food items (FNIs)** and **₱67,000.00** are **financial assistance** through **Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS)** (see Table 1).
