





# DSWD DROMIC Report #7 on the Mw 7.4 Earthquake Incident in Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur

as of 09 December 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 02 December 2023 at 10:37 PM, a 7.4-magnitude earthquake jolted the Municipality of Hinatuan, Surigao Del Sur (08.44°N, 126.59°E - 029 km N 74° E) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus 026 km. The earthquake was also felt in the neighboring municipalities.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 176,357 families or 704,053 persons are affected in 381 barangays in Regions XI and CARAGA (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 829 families or 3,310 persons currently taking temporary shelter in seven (7) evacuation centers in Regions XI and CARAGA (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **21 families** or **63 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives and/or friends (see Annex C).

## c. Total Displaced Population

There are 850 families, or 3,373 persons still displaced in Regions XI and CARAGA (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **5,496 houses** were damaged; of which, **370** are **totally damaged** and **5,126** are **partially damaged** in **Regions XI** and **CARAGA** (see Annex E).





## V. Cost of DSWD Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}57,374,106.31\$ worth of assistance was provided by \$\mathbb{DSWD}\$ to the affected families, of which, \$\mathbb{P}57,307,106.31\$ are food and non-food items (FNIs) and \$\mathbb{P}67,000.00\$ are financial assistance through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) (see Table 1).
