



DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tagpos, Binangonan, Rizal

13 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 December 2023 at around 4:29 AM, a fire incident occurred at Lower Luklukan, Brgy. Tagpos, Binangonan, Rizal.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **73 families** or **343 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Tagpos, Binangonan, Rizal** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **68 families** or **318 persons** sought temporary shelter in the **evacuation center** in **Tagpos Elementary School** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center A total of five (5) families or 25 persons temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population
 A total of 73 families or 343 persons were displaced in Brgy. Tagpos,
 Binangonan, Rizal (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **73** houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Tagpos, Binangonan, Rizal (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱178,120.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱89,060.00 from DSWD and ₱89,060.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
