25 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 20 September 2023 at around 3PM, a flooding incident due to heavy rains occurred in Brgy. Haguimit, La Carlota City, Negros Occidental.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **21 families** or **66 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Haguimit, La Carlota City, Negros Occidental.** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **21 families** or **66 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

Two (2) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Haguimit, La Carlota City, Negros Occidental. (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱35,645.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱15,645.00 from DSWD and ₱20,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
