## **DSWD DROMIC Report on the Tornado Incident in Brgy. Rizal, Anao, Tarlac**

30 December 2023, 6PM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 25 May 2023 at around 4:00 PM, a tornado incident occurred in Brgy. Rizal, Anao, Tarlac, affecting six (6) families' equivalent to 25 individuals. Upon coordination of the DSWD Field Office III with the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office of Anao, Tarlac, the affected families opted to stay with their habitual residence to immediately reconstruct their damaged houses hence, no evacuation were activated.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region III together with the LGU of Anao, Tarlac, provided intervention to support the immediate needs of affected families and individuals by means of relief and financial assistance.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **six (6) families** or **25 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Rizal, Anao, Tarlac.** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **6 families** or **25 persons** currently sought temporary shelter in **Barangay Hall** in **Barangay Rizal Anao, Tarlac** (see Annex B).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **six (6) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1) is totally damaged** and **five (5) are partially damaged** in **Brgy. Rizal, Anao, Tarlac.** (see Annex C).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱52,060.18** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; composed of **₱42,060.18 from DSWD** and **₱10,000.00 from the Local Government Unit of Anao, Tarlac** (see Annex C).
