

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Carabalan, Himamaylan City, Negros Occidental

10 December 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 06 October 2022 at 6:25 AM, an armed conflict incident transpired in Sitio Sig-ang, Brgy. Carabalan, Himamaylan City, Negros Occidental. The Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) stationed in Himamaylan City assisted in the evacuation of displaced families and persons.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **5,444 families** or **26,272 persons** were affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Brgy. Carabalan, Himamaylan City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **1,728 families** or **5,963 persons** sought temporary shelter in **29 evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Carabalan, Himamaylan City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

### b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **146 families** or **570 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

### c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **1,874 families** or **6,533 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Carabalan, Himamaylan City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **three (3) houses** were damaged; of which, **two (2)** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Carabalan, Himamaylan City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱10,434,698.59** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱6,032,218.59** was provided by **DSWD** and **₱4,402,480.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
