## **DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Chemical Spill in Brgy. Sinawal, General Santos City, South Cotabato**

31 December 2023, 6PM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 20 June 2023, at around 10:00 AM, a purported “ammonia Leak” was discovered not far from Buhisan Poultry Farm in Purok Yusaville, Brgy. Sinawal, General Santos City, South Cotabato. It resulted in five (5) children ended up experiencing vomiting and loss of bowel movement (LBM).

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **37 families** or **200 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Sinawal, General Santos City** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **a. Inside Evacuation Center**

A total of **15 families** or **90 persons** sought temporary shelter in **the barangay gymnasium** (see Annex B).

#### **b. Outside Evacuation Center**

A total of **22 families** or **110 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### **c. Total Displaced Population**

A total of **37 families** or **200 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Sinawal, General Santos City, South Cotabato** (see Annex D).

### **IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱25,800.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱10,800.00** from **DSWD**, **₱10,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** and **₱5,000.00** from **NGOs** (see Annex E).
