



DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Easterlies in Caraga Region

10 January 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 December 2023, Caraga Region experienced moderate to occasionally heavy rains due to Easterlies. Certain parts of the region particularly in the province of Agusan del Sur were placed under Orange Rainfall Warning Level and Yellow Warning Level in the provinces of Agusan del Norte, Surigao del Norte, Surigao del Sur and Dinagat Islands. The easterlies brought significant amount of rains which affects families and individuals living in low-lying areas.

In response, local authorities and disaster management teams in Caraga Region actively engaged in the response operation to address the identified immediate needs of affected populace.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **620 families** or **2,524 persons** were affected in **35 barangays** in **Caraga Region** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **601 families** or **2,450 persons** sought temporary shelter in **37 Evacuation Center** in **Caraga Region** (see Annex B).

- b. Outside Evacuation Center
 A total of 19 families or 74 persons temporarily stayed with their relatives nearby the locality. (see Annex C).
- c. Total Displaced Population A total of 620 families or 2,524 persons were displaced (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) **house** was totally damaged due to Easterlies in Caraga Region. (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱52,272.00** worth of assistance from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** was provided to the affected families (see Annex C).
