

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 29, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

30 January 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 26 December 2023 at around 12:10 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Paghidaet, Brgy. 29, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 2:35 PM.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **39 families** or **117 persons** were affected in **Brgy. 29, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **39 families** or **117 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Gymnasium** in **Brgy. 29, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **16 houses** were damaged; of which, **13** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 29, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱344,619.71** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱244,369.71** from **DSWD** and **₱100,250.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
