





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 29, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

30 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 26 December 2023 at around 12:10 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Paghidaet, Brgy. 29, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 2:35 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **39 families** or **117 persons** were affected in **Brgy. 29, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **39 families** or **117 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Gymnasium** in **Brgy. 29, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 16 houses were damaged; of which, 13 are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. 29, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱344,619.71 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱244,369.71 from DSWD and ₱100,250.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
