





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Bayan Luma 9, Imus City, Cavite

11 January 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On December 28, 2023, a fire erupted in the residential area of Brgy. Bayan Luma 9, Imus City, Cavite, triggering the first alarm and was was declared fire out at around 1:03 AM. The incident left 25 families, comprising 91 individuals, displaced and currently temporarily housed at Treelane 3, Bayan Luma 9, Imus City covered court.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in CALABARZON together with the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) of Imus City, immediately conduct profiling and validation and promptly addressed the needs of the affected populace.

Moreover, the LGU of Imus City continuously manage the condition of IDPs and commits to provide interventions as necessary hence, the termination of this report.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **25 families** or **91 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Bayan Luma 9, Imus City, Cavite** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **25 families** or **91 persons** currently still taking temporary shelter at the **Covered Court of Treelane 3** in **Brgy. Bayan Luma 9, Imus City, Cavite** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 25 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Bayan Luma 9, Imus City, Cavite (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱534,243.25 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; composed of ₱159,243.25 from DSWD and ₱375,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
