





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Leon Garcia, Davao City

28 November 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 December 2023 at around 1:14 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok San Vicente, Brgy. Leon Garcia, Agdao District, Davao City. The fire was declared out at around 7:10 AM.

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 135 houses were damaged; of which, 129 are totally damaged and six (6) are partially damaged in Brgy. Leon Garcia, Davao City (see Annex C).
