

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pusok, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu

21 April 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 December 2023 at around 1:25 PM, a fire broke out in Sitio Sta. Maria, Brgy. Pusok, Lapu-Lapu City, and was declared fire out at around 4:57 PM. The incident has led to the displacement of families and individuals residing in the community.

Consequently, the Lapu-Lapu City Government, upon the recommendation of the Lapu-Lapu City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council, has declared Sitio Sta. Maria in Brgy. Pusok under State of Calamity (SoC) last 14 December 2023.

Given the magnitude of the incident, Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM) teams were activated to monitor and secure the welfare and living conditions of the Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs).

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VII, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Lapu-Lapu City, actively engaged in the response operation and promptly provided relief and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected populace and aid their transition to early recovery and rehabilitation. Moreover, activated evacuation centers were officially closed last 08 February 2024, and the evacuees have since returned to their respective residences.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,202 families** or **5,151 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Pusok, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **1,857 families** or **3,527 persons** sought temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Pusok, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **345 families** or **1,624 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **2,202 families** or **5,151 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Pusok, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **581 houses** were damaged; of which, **577** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Pusok, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱73,352,180.70** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱17,388,380.70** from the **DSWD**, **₱30,941,947.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)**, **₱ 5,132,754.00** from **Non-Government Organizations (NGOs)**, and **₱ 19,889,099.00** from **other Partners** (see Annex F).
