

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incident in Malita, Davao Occidental

30 March 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On the night of November 29, 2023, Malita, Davao Occidental faced intense rainfall, causing flooding in Poblacion's barangays. The Municipality Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) swiftly activated emergency responders for search and rescue operations. The local PAGASA bulletin on November 29, 2023, predicted Mindanao would encounter intermittent heavy rainfall, lightning, strong winds, and thunderstorms due to the Easterlies.

On the night of 29 November 2023, Malita, Davao Occidental faced intense rainfall causing flooding in Barangay Poblacion. As forecasted by the local PAGASA weather bulletin Mindanao would encounter intermittent heavy rainfall, lightning, strong winds, and thunderstorms due to the Easterlies. Likewise, the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO), immediately activated the emergency responders to manage the incident caused by the weather system.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,593 families** or **8,887 persons** were affected in **four (4) barangays** in **Malita, Davao Occidental** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **416 families** or **1,336 persons** sought temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Malita, Davao Occidental** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **44 houses** were damaged; of which, **17 are totally damaged** and **27 are partially damaged** in **Malita, Davao Occidental** (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱8,369,105.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱589,135.00** from **DSWD** and **₱7,779,970.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
