



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Ganta, Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur

as of 11 October 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 October 2023 at around 6AM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Ganta, Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur between the 106th Base Command of the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) against the combined force of 105th and 118th Base Commands of the same group. According to reports, the armed encounter also affected nearby barangays and resulted in the displacement of families and individuals.

A total of **1,348 families** or **6,740 persons** are affected in **five (5) barangays** in **Maguindanao del Sur** (see Table 1).
