

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Ganta, Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur as of 11 October 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 06 October 2023 at around 6AM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Ganta, Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur between the 106<sup>th</sup> Base Command of the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) against the combined force of 105<sup>th</sup> and 118<sup>th</sup> Base Commands of the same group. According to reports, the armed encounter also affected nearby barangays and resulted in the displacement of families and individuals.

A total of **1,348 families** or **6,740 persons** are affected in **five (5) barangays** in **Maguindanao del Sur** (see Table 1).
