

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Igpaho, Tubungan, Iloilo as of 19 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 January 2024 at around 10:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the 61st Infantry (Hunter) Battalion of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and members of the Communist Terrorist Groups (CTGs) - Southern Panay Front in Brgy. Igpaho, Tubungan, Iloilo.
