



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Nunangan, Datu Anggal Midtimbang, Magindanao del Sur

as of 25 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 January 2024 at around 9:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired involving two warring commanders of 104th Base Command of the Moro Islamic Liberation Front in Brgy. Nunangan, Datu Anggal Midtimbang, Maguindanao del Sur that resulted in the displacement of families and persons.

A total of **710 families** or **3,550 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Datu Anggal Midtimbang**, **Magindanao del Sur** (see Annex A).

There are **710 families** or **3,550 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).
