On 25 December 2023 at around 11:25 AM, a resident of Brgy. 6, Mercedes, Camarines Norte reported to the Coast Guard Sub-Station Mercedes regarding the man overboard situation at the vicinity waters of the said area. On 26 December 2023 at 3:00 PM, the body of the missing fisherman was found in the vicinity.
