

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Northeast Monsoon in New Washington, Aklan

as of 28 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on January 12, 2024 at 4:00 PM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains caused by the Northeast Monsoon were experienced in Metro Manila, the rest of Luzon, and Western Visayas.

On the same day, coastal barangays in the municipality of New Washington, Aklan experienced heavy rains, strong winds, and rough seas caused by the Northeast Monsoon that eventually had an impact on the livelihood of the families, who are mostly fisher folks, residing in the affected areas.
