





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Shear Line

as of 16 January 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 January 2024 at 4PM, cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and thunderstorms caused by the Shear Line might have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Eastern Visayas, Central Visayas, Caraga, and Northern Mindanao.

On 15 January 2024, the Shear Line continuously affected Caraga, while Davao Region experienced its effects the next day.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **7,180 families** or **33,867 persons** are affected in **60 barangays** in **Regions XI and Caraga** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 1,489 families or 6,257 persons currently taking temporary shelter in 24 evacuation centers in Regions XI and Caraga (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **39 families** or **196 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 1,528 families or 6,453 persons displaced in Regions XI and Caraga (see Annex D).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱ 2,040,476.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱ 1,896,776.00 from DSWD and ₱ 143,700.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex E).

- 136,895 FFPs available at DSWD FOs FOs XI and Caraga.
- 1,093,279 FFPs in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the effects of LPA and Shear Line through inter-FO augmentation.
- ₱1.66 billion worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO warehouses.
